Hedge Cutting Grant: Leitrim County Council will continue to operate the Community Hedge Cutting Grant Scheme for the season 2023/2024. This scheme encourages a joint approach with communities (groups/local residents and landowners) for cutting of hedges /trees along the public roads network which need attention.

- The Grant is €75 per km of roadside hedge/overhanging trees which are cut back.
- The minimum length of roadside hedges is 1km per application.
