

### Christ Risen from the Dead: Our Hope. (From last week)

"Hope dies in you because you lean on the results of human projects. When the march of the Church is colorful and triumphant, when the clergy is numerous and the seminaries full, you say: 'Everything goes well.'

"When the Church is reduced to silence and her witnesses are imprisoned or decapitated, you say: 'All is lost.' The fountain of hope is not in statistics nor in the brightness of any phenomena. Have you forgotten the cross and the grain of wheat? Do you know that the resurrection of the Lord was born in the death of the Lord? Remember the crucifixion and the resurrection are one and the same thing.

"So as not to succumb to discouragement, in moments when results are not visible, rely on the Immortal One of all centuries. We are invincible because the Lord has vanquished all his enemies. The only ruler that remained on earth, and death was also conquered by the Immortal One."
