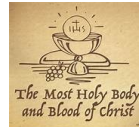

**Walk to Creigharee and Community Street Feast** on Sunday May 24<sup>th</sup>, Heartfelt thanks to all who took part in the walk to Creigharee, joined in the feast, brought food, the musicians and dancers and all who helped in any way with the organisation of the day. We are delighted to announce that over €1800 was raised from contributions on the day which will help provide match funding for the Bóthar na Naomh to Creigharee trail extension. **Parish Funeral Ministry** The Diocesan Parish Pastoral Council is offering 3 nights training for Parishes that would like to develop a funeral Ministry team in their Parish. The idea would be that a minimum of 4 people would be trained to assist families in their journey through bereavement with the loss of a loved one. This would include Meeting with the family of the bereaved. Preparing the Liturgy for the Funeral Mass/ Service. Leading prayers in the presence of the body in the family home, funeral home, Church. Accompanying the family during the funeral Mass. They have requested the Parish Pastoral Councils in Cloone & Aughavas to identify & invite 4 people from each Parish to attend 3 nights of training that will be given in The Family Life Centre, Teallach Íosa, St Mel's Road, Longford on Wed 30th Sept, Wed 7th and 14th October @ 7pm. In preparation, the Pastoral Councils are inviting people of the parishes to let any member of the Parish Council know if they would be prepared to attend the training. Also if you know someone from Cloone or Aughavas whom you feel would be suitable for this work, please approach them and ask them to put their names forward. It is very important that the Parishes send 4 people from each Parish to this training. It is a positive response to the scarcity of priests & the enabling of Lay Catholics to take on some of the Ministry which is presently done by priests, or was formerly done by priests.

**Annual Mission Appeal:** The Annual Mission appeal will be made at Mass on the weekend of the 6th & 7th of June. Bro. Brian Johnson will make the appeal on behalf of the Franciscan Brothers. This is how they describe themselves. "We were founded in Galway in the early 1800's to bring education to the rural poor of Ireland. We were noted in particular for our work with the poor especially during famine times. We also established the first agricultural college in Ireland in Mountbellew Co. Galway in 1904. We now have missions in rural Kenya and Uganda. We run an agricultural college in both countries. Education we feel is a vital key to progress. During times of drought, famine & conflict we help where we can. We are especially involved in reconciliation, the distribution of food, water and medicine during difficult times."
