Reflection

No one can decide how he or she gets to feel at a given moment. Feelings come independently of our wanting or not wanting them. That is within our power is how we act in the face of our feelings. Nowhere is this truer than in how we pray and how we are meant to sustain ourselves in prayer through our adult years. The great spiritual writers assure us that, without exception, we will all have seasons within which our prayer is dry, boring, and can be done only on the basis of dogged will power and commitment. Those same writers then go on to affirm that, because this will be true for everyone, the one, single, non negotiable rule for prayer is simply this: show up! Show up regularly, irrespective of feelings, and irrespective of method. We cannot guarantee how we will feel on any given day, but we can guarantee that, short of an emergency, we will appear. It is not important which method of prayer we use, only that we pray. We show our fidelity to God not in our feelings, but in our commitments.
