## **3RD SUNDAY OF LENT**

### Mass during the period 13th to 29th March in the Diocese of Ardagh and Clonmacnois

In the Diocese of Ardagh and Clonmacnois the following are the arrangements during the period 13<sup>th</sup> March to 29<sup>th</sup> March 2020.

In the current emergency situation, all are dispensed from the obligation to physically attend Sunday Mass.

No weekend or weekday Masses may be celebrated in this diocese during the period. No public Mass will be celebrated on St Patrick's Day. Churches will remain open for prayer. Anniversary Masses scheduled for the dates on which Masses have been cancelled will be rescheduled.

Funeral Masses, Baptisms and Marriages may take place in churches provided less than 100 people are in attendance. Family representatives are asked to ensure that less than 100 will be in attendance, seated 2 metres apart.

A 2 page document outlining the measures to be taken in the Diocese (Diocesan Liturgies 13th -29th March 2020) is on the Church Notice Board.

# **Spiritual Communion**

The tradition of Spiritual Communion, whereby those who cannot directly receive the Eucharist, can by their desire to receive it, also gain its benefits. Although unable to receive the Eucharist in person we are not separated from it, but drawn into a deeper appreciation and desire for its graces, which continue to be poured out to each of us.
