Ask anyone who lives in the same house as you or in your place of work. The journey to perfection begins with us; we have to come to terms with our own limitations before judging other people. The discipline of temperance helps us to understand and appreciate others.

The fruits that we need to produce in our own lives are those suggested by St. Paul; love. joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Here is a challenge for Lent which is now on the horizon. Take each of those nine fruits and sow a little seed of each one each day.
