

The response from the recent Assembly gave a strong mandate to the Interim Diocesan Pastoral Development Committee to further the three conclusions reached at the Assembly – Family Ministry, Youth and Lay Formation.

We as the Mission to Families group, are seeking to establish a Family Mass, once a month, in every Parish of the Diocese during the course of this year. We are seeking volunteers from your Parish to assist with the setting-up of a Family Mass and that together with interested parents of young families, you would invite them to an information workshop that will be held in the Family Centre, Longford (and other venues throughout the Diocese if necessary) in early November.

Resources and necessary materials are available to Parishes and the idea is to encourage younger family members to read, lead in Prayers of the Faithful, bring forward gifts, serve, be part of a children's choir and other areas of Liturgy.
