

Aughavas Parish Improvements Scheme: Following on from our recent AGM which we have to say was poorly attended by local groups and parishioners, and thanks to those who did attend, we now find ourselves due to the rules imposed by the Department in a position where we will be losing 9 workers over the course of the next few months. We have lost 1 worker in January, and 5 in Cloone out of 6 will be leaving by October, 2 in Aughavas and 2 in Carrigallen. At present despite advertising on Jobs Ireland since October we have not been able to recruit any workers.
