Four important Christian Virtues

There are four very important virtues which are an important part of our Christian faith. These four virtues are prudence, justice, temperance and courage. We need to temper our desire for power. An adult mature approach to power is tempered by awareness of others and how we can sustain them, and how we can love them. When Jesus is faced with hunger, he knows what he most deeply desires. Jesus is free for his mission because he is not enslaved by small desires such as getting his own way. **Temperance** is delighting in things as they are, in all God has created, relishing them and savouring them, and using them with great care and respect. Temperance tames the violence of desire which blinds us to what we consume. Justice means giving to each what is due to them. The foundation of all justice is giving to God what is due to God. What is due to God is worship. We worship God in prayer, in the Liturgy, and especially by doing what is right. Prudence means that we should not act without serious thought, without seriously considering what we should do. Pope Paul 6th said "The world is in trouble because of a lack of thinking". We are acting prudently when we do what is right and just. Courage is the fourth great virtue. We need courage to take up our own responsibilities for the life and mission of the Church. We need great courage in order to be able to endure in the Church, to continue in the Church, to remain faithful to the Church. It can be difficult to persevere in the Church when our faith is attacked, or when we are disappointed by the Church, but we are encouraged to endure, regardless of what happens, by Jesus who gave himself to a group of weak and foolish disciples and remained bound to them, even when they rejected him. Our endurance is sustained by hanging on to words of Peter. "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of Eternal life." Our endurance is sustained by meditating on the Gospels. We need courage to leave our own small and cosy world. We need courage to reach out to people who are well distanced from the Church. We need to show them how great it is to know Christ, to love Christ, and to experience the love of Christ. We need courage to move closer and closer to Christ, in order to let the glory shining on the face of Christ, shine on our faces, so that others can come in contact with Christ through our thoughts, our words, and our deeds.
