We are all here at this Eucharist because, at some level, we have come to appreciate Jesus as a wonderful treasure, as a pearl of great price. Either way, Jesus is saying in those parables, that the treasure of the gospel is there to be discovered and to be rediscovered, and those who experience the gospel for the treasure that it is will find a joy that the world cannot give.
