## Message from Bishop Francis Duffy (Third of Three weekend messages):

Married love is a unique form of love between a man and a woman which has a special benefit for society. The word 'unique' is an attractive word because it means there is something special and impressive about it; what is unique should be cared for and protected. Uniqueness is not about equality but about valuing what is distinct and different; distinguishing does not mean discriminating. Not many are saying 'no' publicly and those that are, risk being ridiculed. Fear of social disapproval can lend itself to poor decision making. It is important to reflect deeply on this issue and vote for what you consider the best option. After the referendum the Church continues to support all people and families with its
