

TWENTY NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME, Mission Sunday

Enrolment for Confirmation and First Holy Communion will take place in Cloone Church at 10.00 am and in Aughavas Church at 11.30 am on the Feast of Christ the King 25th Nov. 2012. **Thanks** to the parents for the great turn out for the talk from Fr James McKiernan and Sr Anna Burke on Tuesday last.

Year of Faith: The First Profession of Faith is made during **Baptism**. The symbol of faith is first and foremost the **Baptismal Creed**. Baptism is given 'in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit'.

The **truths of faith** professed during Baptism are explained in terms of their reference to the Holy Trinity.

The creed is divided into three parts: **the first part** speaks of the First Divine Person and the wonderful works of creation; **the next** speaks of the Second Divine Person and the Mystery of his Redemption of men and women; **the final part** speaks of the Third Divine Person, the origin and source of our sanctification.
