Locally in both Parishes we intend to Mark the Eucharistic Congress in Aughavas on Sunday the 10th June at the 11.30 am mass and in Cloone on Sunday the 17th of June at 11.30 am mass. We hope to include the First Holy Communion children in both masses.

We also hope to extend our Adoration in each Parish during the week, with the inclusion of a Holy Hour of prayer, Scripture and Reflections.

During the week of the Eucharistic Congress families are encouraged to set aside some space and time each day for Prayer and Reflection. This can be done by reading the passages in the Bible concerning the Eucharist, The Bread of Life or by reading and reciting prayers to Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. In this respect there are lovely prayers before and after Holy Communion in the First Holy children's preparation programme.
