

Save our Small Schools: At the recent Ballinamore Branch INTO meeting, members felt that it is important to highlight the discriminatory changes that were stealthily imposed in the recent budget including further erosion of school bus transport, change in pupil teacher ratio, withdrawal of financial support to schools, withdrawal of educational supports within schools and threatened closure of local schools. Rural Ireland is under threat. A public meeting will be held in the Commercial Hotel, Ballinamore tomorrow night Monday 30th January at 8 pm.
