Is the mass changing?

The structure of the mass is not changing. The order and the actions of the mass remain unchanged. However, with the introduction of the new edition of the *Roman Missal* throughout the English-speaking world, we will notice a change in how the mass sounds. The translations of a number of our prayer texts from the original Latin have changed—sometimes by a particular word or in the word order. Prayers that we have become used to reciting by memory now have to be relearned. Prayers that we are used to hearing the priest say will sound different to us.

The style of language we will hear and pray may seem more formal to us and perhaps, in parts, more complex. But over time, with the praying of these texts, the sound of the mass will again become familiar to us.

Fr Antonio Benetti of the Comboni Missionaries will talk at all the masses on next weekend 10/11 June '11. He will be making an appeal on behalf of the Order. Fr. Benetti will take up a collection after Holy Communion. Their founder St. Daniel Comboni required his missionaries to be: "Holy and dedicated.... to make common cause...... with the poorest and most abandoned"
