FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Bishop Colm O'Reilly has written to the priests expressing his dismay and disappointment at the Government's decision to legislate for abortion, thereby depriving the most vulnerable, the child in the womb, of life.

He has asked that Prayer Time be held in all parishes on next weekend, 13th and 14th July '13.

We will have some Prayer time in both parishes on Sunday next. In Cloone Parish it will be from 4.00 pm to 5.00 pm and in Aughavas Parish it will be from 5.00 pm to 6.00 pm.

In both parishes we will begin with Exposition of The Blessed Sacrament and quiet prayer for the first half hour, followed by the Rosary and Intercessions for Life.
